Financial Investigation Supervisor

The Financial Investigation Supervisor will oversee the development of financial intelligence, money laundering and counter terrorist financing investigations, managing the uncovering of financial and economic structures, disrupting transnational networks and gathering knowledge of crime patterns as part of a team of specialists.

Principal responsibilities will include but will not be limited to the following:

- i. Investigate illegal fiscal operations especially major proceeds generation and terrorist financing cases;
- ii. Develop financial intelligence through compilation and analysis of documents and evidence to facilitate proactive measures;
- iii. Identification and investigation financial crime through innovation, the use of legislation and proactive opportunities to counteract complex financial crime and minimize impact on the Cayman Islands;
- iv. Obtain orders and warrants in accordance with appropriate legislation and policy as required;
- v. Conduct research in support of criminal investigations and assist in the preparation of crime packages and intelligence material through the focused collation and analysis of data;
- vi. Evaluate and analyze intelligence, compiling reports, preparing target profiles and disseminating in accordance with procedures and policies as necessary;

Qualifications, Skills & Experience:

- I. Certified Anti-Money Laundering Specialist (CAMS) **and**
- II. A minimum of **four (4)** years' experience in fraud risk management or financial investigations in law enforcement or an associated Financial Regulatory Body.
- III. Sound knowledge of International Money Laundering and Terrorism Financing legislation.

- Strong time management, communication, interpersonal, analytical and problem solving skills.
- The ability to effectively research, analyze and develop intelligence leads for Suspicious Activity Reports (SARs);
- Comprehensive knowledge of the international AML/CTF Financial Action Task Force recommendations;
- Understanding of laws, regulations, precedents and legal law enforcement codes;
- Awareness of the operations of the Cayman Islands Government, its personnel, processes and systems;
