






Crime Performance Tables 2018-2022



Total Recorded Crime





The crime figures in these tables do not include Covid-19 offences. Over the course of 2020 and 2021 Covid-19 restrictions had an impact on overall levels of crime and volumes were much lower than would have been anticipated in the future projections completed in 2019.

To put into context the volume of total recorded crime in 2022 is approximately 7% lower than in 2018. The trend line over the last 5 year shows a general decrease from just under 350 crimes per month to approximately 315. However overall levels of crime are starting to go up again. With an increase in population and economic activity post Covid, it would not be unexpected that total crime would increase again in 2023, coupled with associated demands on RCIPS resources.








Robbery Offences


Violent Crime


